7.a	Still water peg boundaries are deemed to be halfway between adjacent or opposing swims.	On still waters, where the adjacent peg is occupied the boundary is halfway to that peg. Where the adjacent peg is unoccupied the boundary is the near leg of the platform or 1 metre from the centre of that peg. The boundary to opposite swims is halfway across the water, regardless of whether or not the peg is occupied.	To bring match rules into line with that of commercial fisheries	Peter Powell	Phil Mansbridge
7.b	End swims are limited to 15 Metres in length and half the width of the water.	Remove this rule	It doesn't apply at the pond and if change to 7.a is accepted this is redundant	Peter Powell	Phil Mansbridge
